



Dear Parents and Carers,

As school has now closed, we have prepared home learning resources for your child/ren. It is a new and challenging time for everyone, but our aim is to support our families as best we can. We appreciate your patience and support during this time. It is important that during this time your child is still having regular learning opportunities to ensure they are meeting the national curriculum objectives. To enable this to happen, we have created homework packs and online assignments to support home learning.

In your homework pack you will find:

- A Weekly Planning Guide- please use this as a guide to help you at home. **You can use the online resources to support you with these activities.**
- A lined writing book for English, Science and Geography writing. Please make sure your child is writing every day.
- Spelling List- use this to practise spellings daily, there are also online resources on Oxford Owl to help here.
- Times Tables Sheet- Children from Year 2 and above to practise daily. There is also the PiXL app to help with times tables practise.
- Reading books - it is important that you are listening to your child read every day to help them with their fluency and comprehension. Oxford Owl, also has eBooks for your child to read.
- SATS revision support for Year 2 and Year 6

Homework packs may differ slightly in each year group. These have been prepared by your class teachers, based on the National Curriculum Objectives for each year group. Where possible we will be setting learning using **Mathletics** and **Purple Mash** as these can be assigned to your child.

**Mathletics**- children can access maths activities
